


Followers of the god Calaan, the Clerics see the consumption of Elex in any form as a sin. Instead they use Elex to power their machines.

Hover over your opponents and fire rounds at them or dive in a devastating melee attack from the sky. Or it could be the best buddy on the run.















#### LASER BLASTER


Pew pew~! The Laser Blaster is a ranged weapon with a high damagege output typical for the Clerics - and for the Albs as well!

#### SKIRT: WEATHERING

The armor and the fabric part of the high cleric outfit looks super batt-leworn.

You create the post apocalyptic look with acrylic paint, spray paint and different tools like a wire brush or sandpaper to distress the fabric.



#### **SEWING: PATTERN**

For the bodysuit you can just buy a pattern, but for all additional elements like the collar you can easily make the pattern by your own.



There are different ways to buit the armor. 3D printing as awesome and super clean. But don't forget all the hours of sanding!



#### LEDs

Light up your costume with LED stripes. They are super thin and can be integrated in small armor parts.



Foam is cheap and works great for armor. You just need a very sharp cutter and a steady hand.

Engravings can be burned in with a soldering iron.



For painting you can use different types of metallic spray paint, and acrylic paint. Also don't forget to give all parts a nice battleworn look.
