




LEDS



SKIRT: WEATHERING

The armor and the fabric part of the high cleric outfit looks super battleworn. You create the post apocalyptic look with acrylic paint, spray paint and different tools like a wire brush or sandpaper to distress the fabric.



SEWING: PATTERN

For the bodysuit you can just buy a pattern, but for all additional elements like the collar you can easily make the pattern by your own.

3D PRINTED ARMOR

There are different ways to build the armor. 3D printing is awesome and super clean. But don't forget all the hours of sanding!



FOAM ARMOR

Foam is cheap and works great for armor. You just need a very sharp cutter and a steady hand.

Engravings can be burned in with a soldering iron.

PAINTING

For painting you can use different types of metallic spray paint, and acrylic paint. Also don't forget to give all parts a nice battleworn look.



LEDs

Light up your costume with LED strips. They are super thin and can be integrated in small armor parts.
